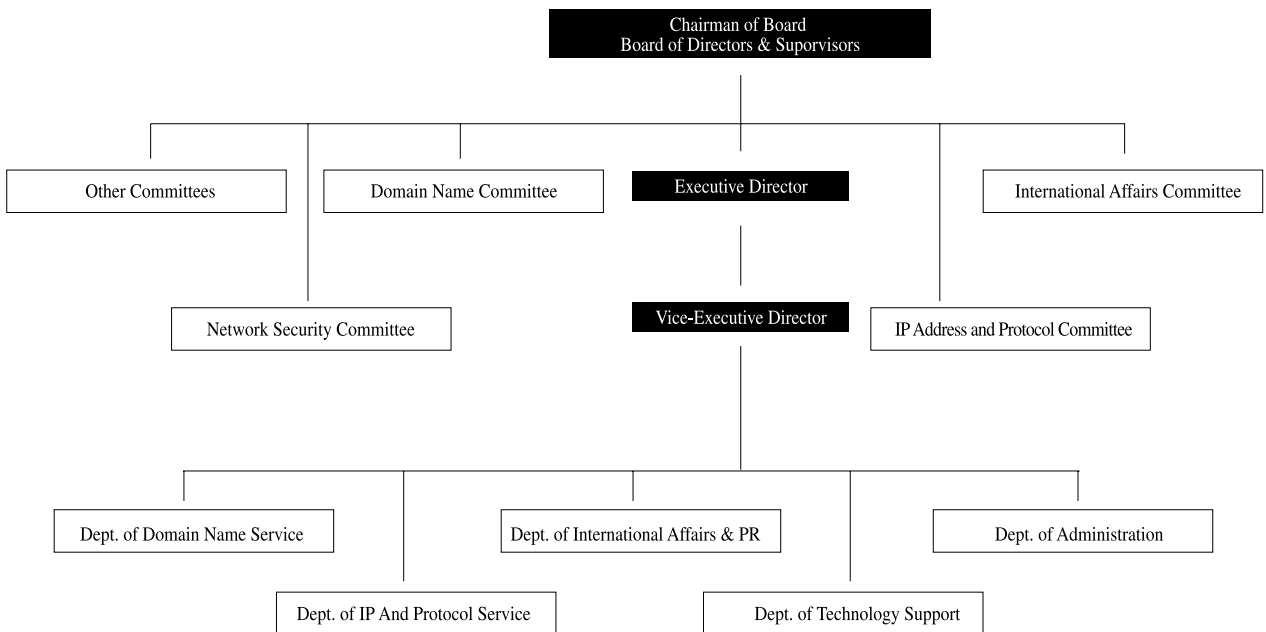
Missions and Duties

As a national network information center, TWNIC is the ccTLD Manager of .tw domain names, and the National Internet Registry (NIR) for IP address. TWNIC has the following fundamental missions and duties :

1. To provide Internet services such as domain name and IP/ASN registration and management, directory and database access as well as the promotion for the nation's Internet business, based on its non-profit, neutral and mutual sharing of network resources.
2. To facilitate and coordinate the activities and co-operation between national and international Internet-related organizations.
3. To assist the promotion of nationwide Internet applications, and to coordinate the exchange and integration of Internet information services.
